Who we are:

The Sarasota Firefighters Benevolent was founded by Sarasota County firefighters in 1996, as a 501 (C) 3 Charitable organization, today our membership is over 480 members strong.

Our mission statement: "Helping Firefighters and their families in times of need".

Our organization helps in times of sickness, injury, and other unforeseen events; we provide financial assistance, with dignity to our members in need.

We also support the community, with an annual "Helping hands for the Holidays", which helps foster children and their families have a meaningful holiday season.

In 2017 in the wake of hurricane Irma the fund created a "Disaster relief fund" to assist firefighters and their families adversely affected by natural disasters.

The majority of our funding comes from fundraising events, sponsorships, and donations.

In 1969 two car enthusiasts, Maurice Devereaux and Tom Kaiser started a car show one Sunday in Devereaux's yard.

The show became know as the Devereaux / Kaiser show, and has continued to grow over the past 49 years, it has been managed by different entities, and has been held in different locations; however the show has alway kept to its roots: no entry fees, and no trophies, plaques or judging... just car enthusiasts enjoying cars, and company on a Sunday!

The Firefighter's Benevolent fund has taken primary ownership of the show, the show will be moved to The Sarasota County Fairgrounds. With your support we hope to make the show bigger and better, continuing to grow, and improve the show for everyone's enjoyment.
